The L-A-D Foundation, Inc., in its ongoing efforts benefitting natural and cultural resources of the Missouri Ozark region, invites ‘Letters of Inquiry’ for funding from nonprofit and public interest organizations.

TYPES OF SUPPORT. The Foundation is interested in new programs and innovative projects that may include environmental education, conservation, cultural resource protection, and restoration projects. Grants are made for program and project-related costs, capital support, seed money, and workshops. No requests for annual or operating support, or support for social events or benefits, will be considered. Generally, grant amounts do not exceed \$5,000. A 12-month grant period is preferred, but multi-year projects may be considered. Applicants must have 501(c)(3) tax exempt status or the equivalent.

DEADLINE FOR LETTERS OF INQUIRY WILL BE: April 3, 2017

Letters of inquiry must not exceed two pages and contain the following information: a description of the organization’s background and experience, a brief project description and goals, amount of the request, and an abbreviated budget describing how the Foundation’s funds would be used.

Letters of inquiry will be reviewed and organizations whose proposals are considered strongest will then be asked to submit more detailed proposals. Final grants for this year will be awarded in **November 2017**.

The L-A-D Foundation encourages organizations to pursue additional support rather than relying on it as a single source of project funding.
